

Please look all the way through the schedule. Consideration of listed conflicts was given and worked with when possible. If your conflict was written at the time of audition you are excused to miss the rehearsal. If you are sick please contact Nikkii by Remind. Be on time to rehearsals and warmed up ready to use our scheduled time. We don't have any extra rehearsals to reteach, if you miss rehearsal you are responsible to get with someone to learn what you missed. Review at home often. Having a parent or friend record at the end of the rehearsal is very helpful. Remember to follow the code of conduct, participant and parent agreements on the audition form, so that this experience will be positive for all. Wear dance clothing to rehearsals (Girls: leotards, tights, dance skirt/shorts and ballet shoes w/hair pulled back. Boys: stretchy pants/shorts, tshirt, bare feet, socks or dance shoes) A detailed costume, hair and makeup email will be sent out after costume fittings. Most girls will need a leotard and/or tan bodyliner, pink tights, and pink ballet shoes. Boys will need black pants, black socks, a white long sleeved button up shirt, and black shoes. For the party: Boys need a vest. Girls will need white bloomers and a jewel toned Victorian style dress. The dress may not be modern, glittered or out of patterned fabric. It can have lace and ruffles. It can have a slip underneath to make it lift, however the slip needs to be appropriate so that the dancer can still dance full out and sit down. Please make the length of your dress right below the knee, not longer. We do have a few dresses from the past or previous cast members that may be willing to borrow dresses. These will go quickly, so don't wait. The Staulenbaum family in the show is dressed in blue, so no blue dresses or vests for other party guests. Dresses need to be passed off to Nikkii by Oct. 25. You can contact her through the Remind system or at rehearsal. All costume pieces will need to be in the auditorium and stay there by Nov 8. If you are not receiving remind texts send Nikkii a personal text (435)660-1986 or email the JFAC email. We don't want anyone to miss any info. We are so excited!
